Humanism – approach to life, focusing on wisdom of the ancients, and achievements of individuals.

Castiglione – wrote a guide to courting. (dating)

Patron – gives money to support art

Perspective – art technique that makes things look 3-D

Da Vinci – multi-talented man, good at a lot of different subjects. Careful attention to detail and anatomy. “Renaissance Man”

Women Artists- kept work secret because of discrimination

Renaissance Art used Greek and Roman styles

*The Prince* – was a guide for rulers written by Machiavelli.

Northern Renaissance delayed – lack of economic growth and the plague

Thomas More – wrote *Utopia* – his vision of social reform in an ideal world

Vernacular – written/spoken in everyday language. Read by the middle class.

The Printing Press – Gutenberg – Impact – produce books faster – ideas can spread faster.
